### **What are British values?**

- Developing personal and social responsibility
- Respect for British Institutions

These values flow through Hannah Ball School, from our ethos and vision, to our policy and practice in the classroom. We expect all those within our school community to live by these principles so that we develop a harmonious and cohesive school community. We value and celebrate the diverse heritages of everybody at Hannah Ball. Alongside this, we value and celebrate being part of Britain. In general terms, this means that we celebrate traditions and customs in the course of the year.

We also consider it essential for our staff to lead by example and exemplify and model British values. British values are therefore built into our staff induction processes and reiterated in all staff training exercises.
