IT GAVE THEM AN OPPORTUNITY TO SEE THAT BOYS AND GIRLS CAN SHARE THE SAME INTERESTS.

#### YEAR 3

YEAR 3 PUPILS HAVE HAD A SUPER START TO THIS HALF TERM. THEY HAVE ALL COME BACK KEEN TO GET ON WITH THEIR LEARNING AND THIS HAS BEEN LOVELY TO SEE. #### **YEAR FOUR**

YEAR 4 HAVE HAD AN EXCITING START TO THE NEW TERM. WE KICKED OFF THE WEEK WITH A VISIT TO A SYNAGOGUE WHERE THE CHILDREN EXPLORED A JEWISH PERSON'S PLACE OF WORSHIP. THIS VISIT ALLOWED THEM TO APPLY THEIR LEARNING FROM CLASS INTO A PRACTICAL SETTING. I AM VERY PROUD TO SAY THE CLASS BEHAVED EXCEPTIONALLY WELL AND ASKED SOME INTERESTING QUESTIONS TO EXTEND THEIR LEARNING. THE CLASS ALSO HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO TASTE SOME SPECIAL JEWISH SWEET BREAD CALLED 'CHALLAH'. THERE ARE SOME PICTURES OF OUR VISIT ATTACHED. IN ENGLISH WE HAVE MOVED ONTO OUR NEW UNIT AND WILL BE STUDYING 'HARRY POTTER AND THE PHILOSOPHER'S STONE'. THE CHILDREN MADE SOME EXCELLENT PREDICTIONS AND THEY ARE NOW LOOKING FORWARD TO READING THE STORY TO SEE IF THEIR PREDICTIONS WERE CORRECT. IN SCIENCE, OUR NEW TOPIC THIS TERM IS 'STATES OF MATTER'. YEAR 4 ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO PLANNING SOME EXCITING NEW EXPERIMENTS IN THE COMING WEEKS.

#### **YEAR FIVE**

THIS WEEK, YEAR 5 HAVE BEGUN THEIR NEW TOPIC ALL ABOUT THE EGYPTIANS AND HAVE STARTED INVESTIGATING MATERIALS IN SCIENCE WITH AN EXCITING EXPERIMENT. WE HAVE CREATED A GLOSSARY OF NEW VOCABULARY TO ADD TO EACH LESSON. THE CHILDREN CAME UP WITH SOME FANTASTIC PROPERTIES AND ADJECTIVES TO DESCRIBE THE MATERIALS THAT WE INVESTIGATED. IN WRITING, WE HAVE STARTED LEARNING OUR NEW TEXT, THE PRINCE OF EGYPT AND THE CHILDREN ARE REALLY ENJOYING IT. IN HISTORY, WE HAVE CREATED A TIMELINE TO SHOW HOW LONG THE ANCIENT EGYPTIAN CIVILISATION LASTED, ADDING KEY EVENTS AS OUR TOPIC PROGRESSES.

#### **YEAR SIX**

THIS WEEK, YEAR 6 HAVE STARTED THEIR NEW TOPIC, 'WORLD WAR II'.

TO START OFF, WE LOOKED AT HOW THE WAR BEGAN AND AND ORDERED EVENTS ON A TIMELINE AFTER LISTENING TO NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN'S ANNOUNCEMENT. IN ENGLISH, WE BEGAN OUR NEW STORY, 'ROSE BLANCHE' WHICH IS ABOUT A YOUNG GIRL LIVING IN GERMANY THROUGH THE WAR. IT IS A WONDERFUL PICTURE BOOK AND YEAR 6 HAVE BEEN ENJOYING THE STORY SO FAR, MAKING EXCELLENT PREDICTIONS AND INFERENCES. THEY'RE ALL VERY CURIOUS TO SEE HOW THE STORY ENDS WHICH THEY'LL FIND OUT TODAY! IN MATHS YEAR 6 HAVE BEEN WORKING ON THEIR PROBLEM SOLVING SKILLS USING THE FOUR OPERATIONS. WE ALSO STARTED OUR NEW SCIENCE TOPIC WHICH IS 'ELECTRICITY' AND WE LOOKED AT THE SCIENTIFIC SYMBOLS ASSOCIATED WITH CIRCUIT EQUIPMENT.

FOR HOMEWORK, YEAR 6 HAVE BEEN GIVEN 3 CGP BOOKS ( SPAG, COMPREHENSION AND MATHS) WHICH THEY WILL TAKE HOME EACH FRIDAY AND RETURN EACH WEDNESDAY WITH SPECIFIC PAGES COMPLETED. IN THEIR PLANNERS EACH WEEK, THEY WILL MAKE A NOTE OF THE PAGES THEY ARE REQUIRED TO WORK ON IN EACH BOOK. PLEASE MAKE SURE THE WORK IS COMPLETED IN PENCIL, KEPT NEAT, ALL WORKING IS SHOWN IN THE BOOKS AND THAT THE BOOKS ARE LOOKED AFTER.
