## Parent's Voice

This section is about sharing your voice with the rest of the community. Parents in our school have asked for more information on Autism

Autism Toolbox is a Parent Portal for parents/carers by Autism Early Support.

As part of council's universal offer to families, the Parent's Portal by Autism Early Support (AES) was commissioned to provide free online support and guidance services for Buckinghamshire families, and professionals.

The Parent's Portal by AES offers support to parents/carers of children aged 2 to 17 years who:

- may have recognised differences in the child and are exploring neurodivergence, for example, they may have Googled 'Is my child autistic?', spoken with a GP, health visitor or school
- have an autistic child(ren) (self-identified or diagnosed)
- are awaiting an ASD/ADHD assessment for their child(ren)
